Concentration: In addition to the core requirement, every student in the Liberal Studies Subject Matter Program must complete 12 units of advanced study in a specific area. There can be no overlap of courses. These units must be taken from within one of the Concentrations (Biology, English, Intercultural Studies, Mathematics, Physical Education, United States History, and World History). A list of approved courses is available in the Education Department.
