

Art Scholarship Application

For *new* art majors at BIOLA University

Each year the Department of Art offers several art scholarships to incoming new students. These awards are determined on a competitive basis and require the submission of an art portfolio and artist's statement. All students are encouraged to participate in this process.

PORTFOLIO

The portfolio should include 10 images in CD-Rom format, Macintosh compatible. All materials should be labeled with artist's name, title of each piece (if any), media, dimensions, and year completed. Portfolio artwork may include drawings, painting, photography, ceramics, digital works, mixed media, printmaking, sculptures, et cetera. Self-portraits, still lifes and figure studies are recommended. Portfolios may include coursework or artwork created outside of art courses, preferably within the past two years.

ARTIST'S STATEMENT

The Artist's Statement should include your reasons for wanting to be an artist, a description of artists and/or work that you admire, and your academic and artistic goals. Your statement should be about one page (single spaced) in length. Be sure to include your name at the top of your statement.
